### **About the organisation**

Bangarra is widely acclaimed nationally and around the world for its powerful dance language and distinctive theatrical voice. The company delivers a diverse annual regional, national and international touring program, which is complemented by an extensive program of community, youth and education workshops and initiatives. Since inception, and particularly during the last five years, Bangarra has grown in its reach and strengthened its engagement within communities, and with both national and international audiences

### **About the role**

The role of videographer is central to Bangarra's reputation as a powerful storytelling organisation deeply rooted in strong connections with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities. In this role, you would be responsible for capturing our critically acclaimed dance performances and community projects. Your work will be used to increase the profile of the organisation's digital brand across multiple channels. Applicants must be based in Sydney and willing to travel as the company tours on a regular basis.

This is a 12-month contract that will start January 2020.

### **Applicants must have:**

- Formal training in media and communications with strong editing skills
- Several years' experience in filming dance and movement, with the capacity to work with music
- Strong organisational and project management skills with the ability to manage filmed projects from start to finish
- Experience working within organisational processes and within reporting lines
- The capability to take initiative by communicating ideas and incorporating directions from the leadership team
- Some experience creating, filming and editing short films
- Current Working with Children Check or willingness to apply for one upon being successful
- The capacity to tour and travel on a regular basis.
- Experience working with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people.

**Desirable criteria:**

- Experience working in Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities.
- An understanding of sensitivities when working with Youth and Elders in these communities.
- An understanding of cultural protocols for filming on homelands.

**On a personal level you will be able to succeed in this role if you have:**

- Resilience with the skills to work in varying conditions
- Ability to cope with change including last minute requests
- The aptitude to work autonomously to meet deadlines without needing direction
- A genuine interest sharing the stories of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities with respect and honesty
